This led to an offer of formal training from Placido Domingo. He has now recorded several albums, appeared in opera and symphony concerts, and performs in support of numerous charities throughout the United States and abroad.

This will be his first-ever performance in Southeastern Michigan.
2011 is the 10th Anniversary of the 911 disaster.
He will be accompanied by the Jesse Lynch Trio from New York City.
There should be great interest in this one-time performance.
